Aluxes and the Palenque archaeological zone

Operation Every day / Shared tour

Departure from Palenque

We will pick you up from your hotel lobby at 8:00 am to visit the Palenque archaeological site. We will begin in the main plaza of the Palenque archaeological zone where you can admire the Temple of the Inscriptions, the Palace, the Temple of the Crosses, the Foliated Cross, and other mounds. We will continue to the pedestrian walkway and descend for 30 minutes, observing flora and fauna, waterfalls, and arriving at the site museum (closed Mondays) where you can see a replica of King Pakal's tomb. (Total visit time: 3 hours)

We continue with the Los Aluxes ecopark, a wildlife rescue center in the region, where you can see red macaws, jaguars, monkeys, manatees, crocodiles, tapirs, deer, among many other species; finally, return to the hotel in Palenque arriving at approximately 3:00 pm.

The tour operator will pick you up from your hotel. As this is a shared service, there may be slight variations in the pick-up time depending on traffic and weather conditions.
