

Indigenous Villages San Juan Chamula and Zinacantán

Minimum 1 person to reserve

Operates every day / Shared service tour

Departure from San Cristóbal de las Casas

We will go to your hotel to start the journey towards Zinacantán where we will arrive at the house of indigenous artisans who are dedicated to the waist loom, they also invite us to go to the kitchen to try the tortillas and the pox (traditional alcoholic drink made from corn and sugar cane). At the end of the visit to the house of the artisans we will go to the church of San Lorenzo in Zinacantán (entrance fee not included)

Then we go to the church of San Juan Chamula, where the guide will explain about the traditional rituals, uses and customs of this town. (If you wish to enter the interior of the church, the cost of access is not included. Right there they offer cleaning rituals with an additional cost not included.) To respect the customs of the community, it is important that you know that it is not allowed to take pictures inside the church or in the main square when there are religious events, and not to wear a hat or caps inside the church.

We return to San Cristóbal and finish in the center of the city. You will need to transfer to your hotel on your own.

Note: Children from 0 to 2 years old do not pay and travel in the arms and/or legs of their parents or guardians.

If you cancel 8 days or more before the start date of your service, you will have a cancellation fee of 10% of the total services reserved.

The tour operator will pick you up at your hotel, as it is a shared service there could be variations of minutes in the pick up times, depending on traffic and weather conditions.
